In order to do this, we have developed a initial assessment for every learner to ensure we gather the correct information, listen to their wants and needs and develop a pathway that caters for their ability level of support needed at that moment in time.

This approach is used for both vulnerable people looking for a career pathway and employability opportunities and also those wanted to up-skill themselves and/or their workforce.



Initial Assessment Process

Our initial process ensures we correlate and extract the most important information to create a picture of who the learner is. Including the driving motivators, challenges and barriers. We use this information to produce a detailed person-centred, progressive and development plan and align vocational courses that are right for them.



Review of all existing relevant information on the learner (EHCP, previous education/training/employment etc)

1:1 meetings with tutor and learner. Introduction to vocational taster sessions to gather insights into their personality and what direction is appropriate for them

Pen Portrait of the learner to empower their own voice and express interests, likes, dislikes

We create 3 scaling criteria's and then base the short, medium and long term training plan and goals around them.

We arrange regular reviews to update the training, support and progress, based on the development of the learner

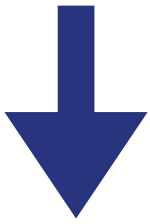

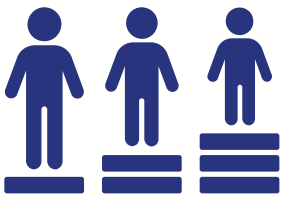

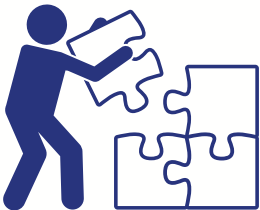

Example Training Pathways



We work very closely with businesses and local authorities to ensure young people out of work and in employment have the correct pathways to gain qualifications that lead into paid work, a sustainable and suitable career. With building a partnership with local businesses, we can help every step of the way with the learners journey into work and also the employer to provide the necessary support for the development of their workforce.

We have two pathways for learners:

- **Train to work**

This pathway is when learners need training before being able to start work experience and applying for jobs. This is tailored to our vocational courses for people that are out of work and with all of our courses, we work with local business that relate to their course for them to gain experience at the end of the course.

- **Work based training**

This is for a range of people whether they out of education, already in a job and looking to up-skill themselves or wanting to develop in their career with apprenticeships/qualifications. With these training programmes, we create the pathway whereby they complete their training and gain work experience at the same time and learn on the job as well.

Both of our pathways work closely with the learner and employers to build relationships and so we are involved in the whole journey.

Example Training Pathways



Two examples of a 6 week training programme for Hospitality Vocational Courses for 16+

Example 1 Barista Course

Initial assessment & introduction into taster hospitality courses



Registration on Barista course based on interests and abilities. Extra support in Maths & English needed & Employability Skills



5 day course on an accredited Barista course that is partnered with local businesses



2 weeks work experience with partnered business, whilst working towards Maths & English quals.



Review of work experience, likes, dislikes, strengths and weaknesses and secure interview date with work experience employers (or any others)



CV building and interview preparation with tutor



Interview for paid work or work with our careers options team

Two examples of a 6 week training programme for Hospitality Vocational Courses for 16+

Example 2 Cooking Course

Initial assessment & introduction into taster hospitality courses



Registration on Cooking course based on interests and abilities. Pathway after this course is to move onto more advanced course as a cooking course covers many areas.



5 week course on accredited Introduction to Cooking course. 1 day in centre and 4 days work experience with partnered business. Potential paid work-based learning opportunities. Weekly check in with tutor on progress and career development options based on course



End of course: the learner has an option to continue and can decide on further qualifications/apprenticeships working with The Greenhouse and partnered employers. They have the option to work with our careers team to find other opportunities if needed.

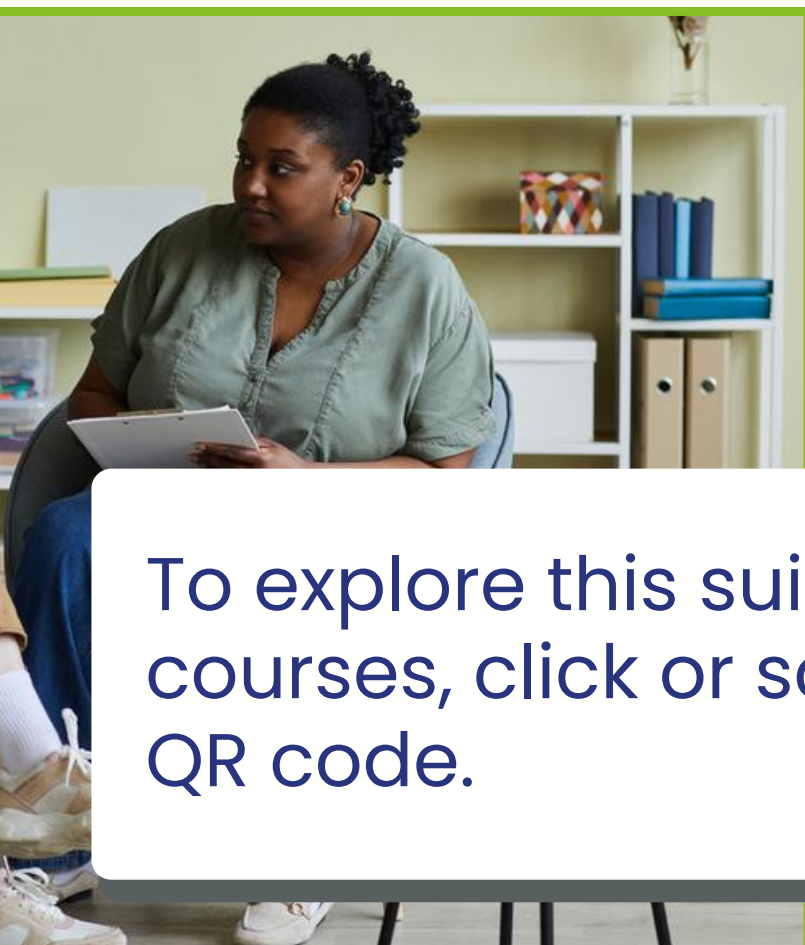

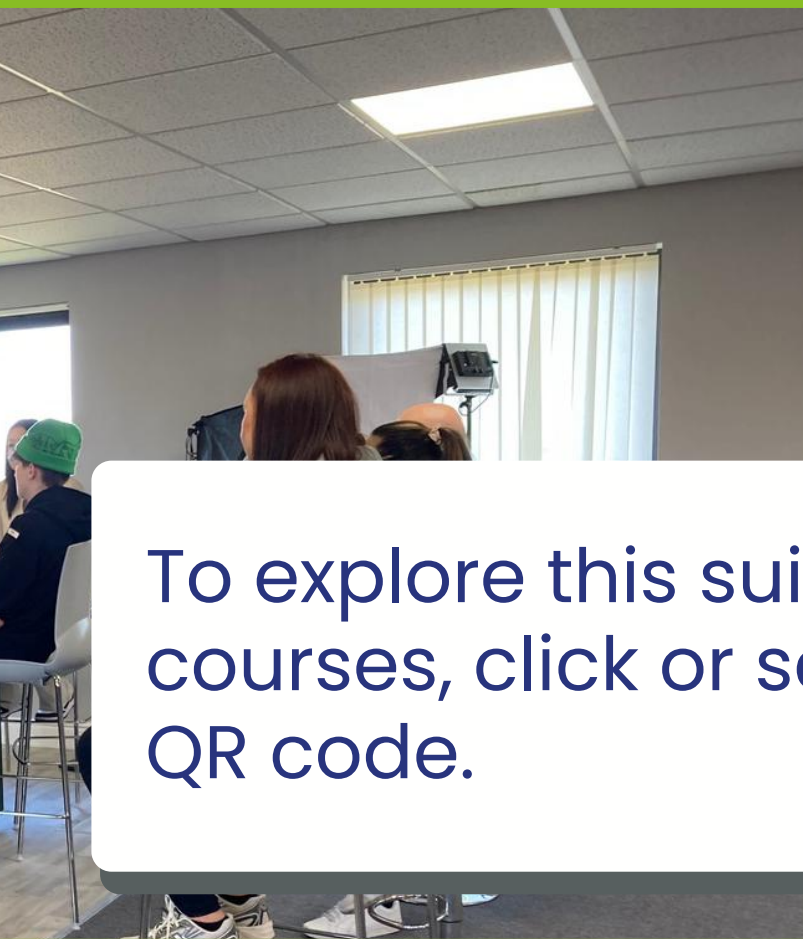
Hospitality Suite

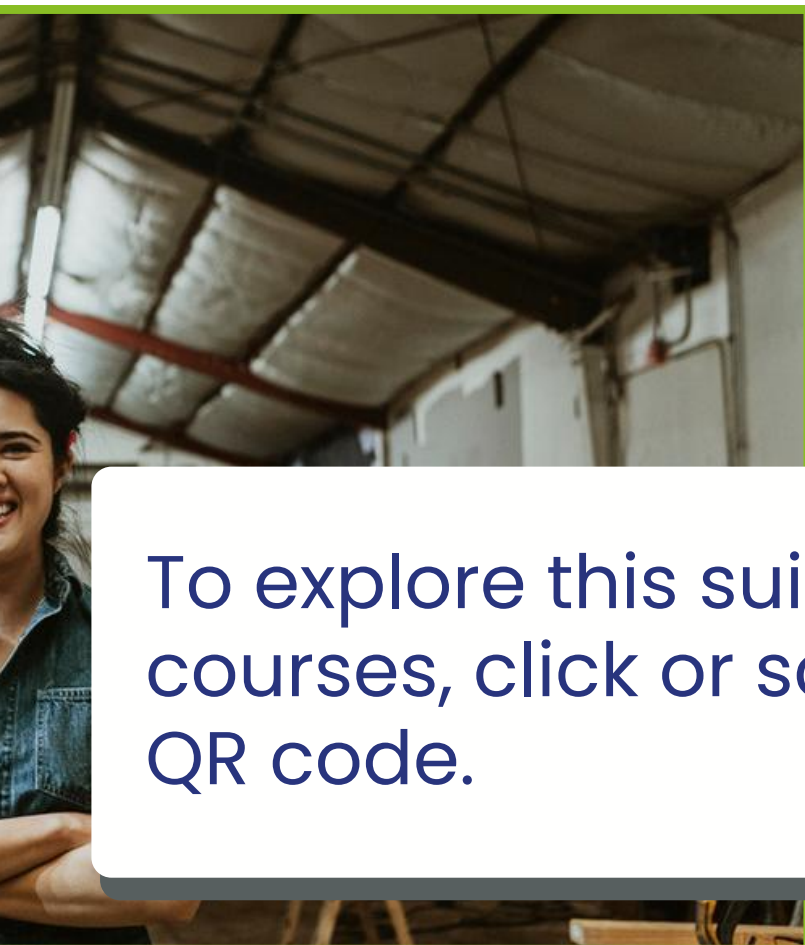
