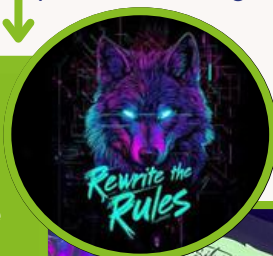

Art Therapy Day

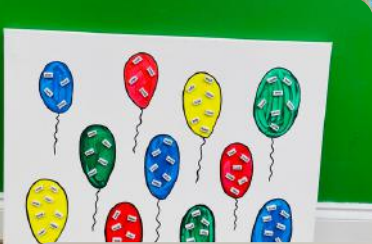


End of year Art Therapy class

Transition to Post 16 at the Hyflex Academy
